## Eyeliner Tattoo Aftercare

Semi-Permanent make up or Cosmetic Tattoo is deposited into the skin very lightly so that it fades away over time. This means you will need a touch up after 4-6 weeks to get them looking perfect.

After the touch up session your eyeliner will stay for around 3 years. We recommend getting a small touch up every 1-2 years to keep them really black. During the first 2 weeks you will get a little flaking over the tattoo, this is normal.

When the flaking finishes, you will most likely see a few lighter spots where the skin pushes the colour out. This is why all cosmetic tattoo's need a touch up session, after the touch up your eyeliner is perfect. Please book your touch up today.

Please follow these after care instructions perfectly, if you do not care for your eyeliner for the following 2 weeks while they heal you will lose more colour. Your eyeliner will look darker today and for the next week or so and until they settle to a beautiful soft black.

## Please follow these instructions:

- Don't touch the eyeliner at all during the healing process.
- You will be experiencing "dry healing" on the area. this means no water on the area for a
  minimum of 10 days this includes sweating. When showering or washing your face, please make
  sure water is not running into the eyes. You can use oil free facial wipes to wash your face, just
  make sure you are avoiding the eye area.
- Have sunglasses available as your eyes may be light sensitive or even dilated immediately after your treatment.
- Don't pull any flaky bits off the eyeliner, this will pull colour out.
- If you need to wash your hair, please tilt your head back so the water does not run over your face and through the eyeliner. If water does wet the eyeliner, softly dab with a tissue, don't wipe.
- You may wear makeup straight after getting this done but no eye make-up or mascara for 1week.
- You will have slight swelling on the eyeliner tattoo today and tomorrow, you can apply a cold pack if needed.
- After the procedure is completely healed, you make go back to your regular cleansing and makeup routine. Avoid scrubbing the area. Use sunblock after the procedure area is healed to protect from sun fading.
- No exfoliants, retinol acids, glycolic acids and alpha hydroxy acids on the area for 30 days after the appointment as this can cause premature fading.
- Avoid eye creams, night creams, moisturizers, lash tinting, lashes extensions and false lashes until healed.
- No Vaseline, Bepanthen and any other petroleum-based products.
- No activities that will cause sweating for 10 days.
- No swimming pools, hot tubs or other bodies of water for 14 days.
- No UV exposure (including tanning booths).
- No massages, facials or skin treatment, threading, waxing or hair removal products on or around the treatment area.
